

TERMS & CONDITIONS AT CLISSOLD PARK TAVERN

FOR BOOKINGS

- Clissold Park Tavern requires a £5 per head minimum spend for every booking, and this must be paid in advance. Your booking is not confirmed until this deposit has been received.
- Your advanced payment is non-refundable, and is to be spent in full on the day. Any remaining money from your deposit cannot be returned to you. In the event of cancellation, we may be able to move your reservation to a different date or time, however this is not guaranteed.
- Any changes to your booking must be communicated at least 48 hours in advance and may require additional deposits to be paid. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to accommodate your request.
- By making this booking you agree to follow the new Tier 2 rules and that you and your party need to order a substantial meal each in order to be served alcohol. You also agree to remain seated for the duration of your visit, and to wear a face mask whenever you are not. Mixed households must be seated outside.
- Table bookings are for two hours maximum, and are not be able to be extended under any circumstances.

FOR WALK-INS

- Tables are for two hours maximum and cannot be extended. You will be told this upon entry and agree to this by taking the table.
- We can only accept walk-in tables of a maximum of 6 people, including children and babies.
- By taking the table you also agree that all guests will eat a substantial meal in order to be served alcohol, without exception. You also agree to remain seated for the duration of your visit, and to wear a face mask whenever you are not. Mixed households must be seated outside.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Bookings will be expected to self police regarding social distancing and groups of different households. We will only be taking bookings for maximum groups of six for the time being - including children and babies.
- We do not have a cloakroom, and are not responsible for any property left behind.
- Abuse of any kind to our staff will not be tolerated and you will be removed from the premises and barred reentry.
- We reserve the right to refuse entry. Management will remove any guest from the venue in accordance with their responsibility under the licensing act.
- The possession or consumption of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited, any guest found possessing or consuming illegal drugs will be ejected and reported to the police.
- Under 18s can only be on the premises until 7pm, both inside and out. Children will be expected to be well behaved and remain seated during your visit.
- If you or someone you have been in contact with, are unwell, please do not enter the pub under any circumstances.
